

RE-GATHER SAPC SUNDAY WORSHIP

Below is information that will let you know what to expect for RE-GATHER SAPC. If you have questions, feel free to call the church office (803-732-2273).

Two services will be offered: 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. The 9:00 a.m. service will be a mask required service (masks to be worn upon entering the sanctuary and not removed until outside the building). At the 10:30 a.m. service masks are encouraged but not required.

Both services will be held in the sanctuary. Space will be limited based on social distancing and maximum capacity recommendations.

Access to the sanctuary will be available at 8:30 a.m. for the 9:00 a.m. service and 10:15 a.m. for the 10:30 a.m. service. If arriving earlier please remain in your vehicles until the respective times.

Child care is not available for the 9:00 a.m. service. It is available for 9:30 growth classes and the 10:30 a.m. service.

Families are asked to sit together during worship.

Pastors, staff, and ushers will be wearing masks (other than when on the platform). Healthcare advice is that universal use of masks is the most helpful step in such situations.

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building.

Everyone attending is asked to practice social distancing, 6 feet for non-family, at all times while on campus. This includes no handshakes or hugs.

Seating will be facilitated by ushers on every other pew with 6 feet between family groups alternating pews from one service to the next. All pews in the side balconies are available for seating.

Complete worship guides with the Scripture and hymns will be pre-placed in the pews for your convenience.

Tithes, offerings, attendance and Faith Mission Giving cards, may be placed in the collection baskets at the entrances and exits to the sanctuary and Great Hall.

Those wishing to fellowship after the service are encouraged to exit the building and do so outside in the safest manner.

If you are not feeling well, symptomatic in any way, in an at-risk group or concerned about your family's vulnerability, or if you have been around anyone who has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus, please plan to take part in our Livestream Online Gathering from home. Please know that the Session and pastoral staff understand and support any member's decision to remain at home during this time.
