the Great Commission



Just before ascending to Heaven, Jesus gave His final instruction to His followers. He told them to “Go.” Christians are not an inactive people. Certainly, we are to worship the Lord and study His Word as we sit at the feet of Jesus. But the duty of a disciple doesn’t stop there. Jesus tells us to “Go!” reproduce ourselves by making disciples of all the nations.

Our annual Faith Mission Giving Emphasis is the ideal time to reflect and evaluate our individual and corporate response to Jesus’ priority. At St Andrews, we highlight going to the nations in three directions: **Across the Street** (local missions and outreach), **Across the Country** (gospel efforts in our region and country), and **Across the World** (international missions). We further emphasize three ways in which to “go:” *Pray*, *Give*, and *Go*. Everyone can pray for someone. Everyone can give something. Everyone can go somewhere.

And we can “Go Boldly!” because of the promises that accompany the command. Jesus said that He has all authority in heaven and on earth and that He will be with us always. What more do we need to fulfill this “Great Commission”?

The challenge for us is *not* knowing exactly how to pray, *not* coming up with the money we will give, *not* mustering up the courage to go. The challenge for us is to exercise faith in all three of these areas. Are you willing to step out in faith by praying for our partners that are listed in this publication? Are you willing to step out in faith by pledging to give something to the mission’s efforts at SAPC? Are you willing to step out in faith by asking the Lord to show you where you can go with the hope of the gospel?

Our verse of the year, Hebrews 11:6, reminds us that “without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that he rewards those who seek Him.”

Exercise your faith and “Go Boldly!” in missions this year. See how God will reward that faith by “working in you that which is pleasing in His sight.”
